Kilmorack Gallery is pleased to announce *Universal Wonder*, an exhibition of new collaged paintings by Colin Brown (b 1962,) marking the Stonehaven-based artist's continued exploration of the world through collage. Collage is a medium often associated with Pop Art, taking images from popular culture and remaking them for a different time but investing them with the imprint of past lives.

Universal Wonder is a celebration of twelve of Colin Brown's latest paintings, created after forty years as a dedicated collage-artist – traveling for inspiration and material, snipping, pasting, composing and painting. These works embody collage in its truest form – looking in all directions: past and present, here and far, far away. They reach out, touch and pop with energy.

Brown sees these latest works as 'celebration of the positive spirit of contemporary society and his ongoing joy in finding and using collage elements as a fundamental part of his work.' These elements can be anything that resonates with him: prints from Edo Japan, Redoute's botanical paintings of birds, flowers and butterflies or images a jazz or sporting great.

Colin Brown grew up in Kingussie, Scotland, and graduated from Duncan of Jordanstone College of Art with B.A. Honours Degree in Fine Art (Painting) and a Post-Graduate Diploma in Fine Art (Painting). He was the

recipient of an RSA John Kinross Scholarship to study in Florence (1987) and the Pollock-Krasner Award from the Pollock-Krasner Foundation, New York (1996). He has worked extensively in Europe, including four years in Düsseldorf and now lives in the northeast of Scotland.
